The city of Madrid offers many attractions and places that you cannot miss. Visit them from any of the following hostels.

### 1. Albergue Juvenil Richard Schirrmann

This Hostel is located in the Casa de Campo de Madrid, 15 minutes from the city centre, and boasts large open gardens, several meeting rooms and a bus parking lot. Ideal for schools and institutions that seek to combine cultural trips with leisure activities in natural surroundings. Come once, repeat forever!



### 2. Albergue Juvenil Santa Cruz de Marcenado

With its very central location and good connections, this hostel provides an ideal base for young people and groups, from around the world, to sleep and eat a good breakfast before going out to explore the capital and its surroundings. A classic in Madrid. Temporarily closed.



### 3. Albergue Juvenil San Fermín

Located 15 minutes from the city centre with easy access from the M-30 and M-40 motorways. This hostel offers facilities to accommodate groups visiting Madrid and also to organise all kinds of seminars, courses and events. You'll be pleasantly surprised.

## San Lorenzo de El Escorial. Historic-artistic heritage

Let yourself be seduced by this city by visiting the monastery that was the political center of Felipe II, strolling through the old town and discovering the interesting natural environment that surrounds this enclave. An inescapable date with history.

## Guadarrama. National Park and surroundings

Here you will find ideal facilities for groups who want to learn and explore the Guadarrama mountains and the Lozoya Valley. Some of these shelters and hostels provide access to Mount Peñalara, from where you can reach the so-called Siete Picos, follow the Cuerda Larga trail, or trek across La Pedriza mountain. You won't want to miss it out!

## Navacerrada and its environment

If you love nature you can enjoy one of the destinations in the mountains of Madrid that are worth visiting in any season of the year. Come, you will be amazed!

### 5. Refugio Juvenil del Pingarrón

This magnificent mountain retreat is located in the port of Cotos to Valdesquí.

### 6. Albergue Juvenil Los Batanes



Los Batanes youth hostel located in Rascafría, opposite the Monastery of El Páucar, is an ideal spot for participating in all manner of environmental activities and sports, within the natural setting of the Sierra de Guadarrama National Park. A truly charming place to stay.

## 7. Albergue Juvenil Las Dehesas



Escape to this hostel in Cercedilla, gateway to the Guadarrama National Park, and reward yourself with any of the activities available in the Fuenfría Valley: hiking, mountain biking, horse-back riding ... Just what you deserve.

## 8. Albergue Juvenil Villa Castora

This landmark hotel is located in Cercedilla, in the mountains, and only one hour from Madrid. Five work-rooms make it a perfect venue for educational and cultural activities, sports or contact with nature. A sure hit.



## 9. Refugio Juvenil El Palancar



Located near the port of Morcuera, at 6 and a half kilometers from Rascafría. This site is worth a visit in bike, hiking or just for the pleasure of a stroll.



## 10. Refugio Juvenil Puerto de la Morcuera

At the top of the port of Morcuera 1.796 meters above sea level, we enjoy spectacular views of the Valley of the Lozoya, under the peak La Najarra. Come at any time of the year.



## 11. Refugio Juvenil Villamanrique de Tajo



Located in the town of Villamanrique de Tajo, this shelter offers groups an ideal base for hiking and cycling trails, in addition to a workroom and a good courtyard for their activities.

## The region of Las Vegas. Scenery and culture

Discover a landscape marked by the river Tajo and go all over it through its ecological path. Enjoy a natural environment full of charm.

## Youth hostels

Youth hostels are accommodation facilities designed preferably for youngsters, although people of all ages are entitled to use them. They are open virtually all year round and offer dormitories sleeping between 2 and 8, as well as work rooms, common areas and meal servi-


ce. Because of its facilities and the surroundings, they offer an ideal point from which to pursue educational and training, sports, environmental and leisure activities. No hostel card is required.

## Youth shelters

Youth shelters offer basic accommodation facilities, equipped with an infrastructure to make the stay more welcoming for groups and encourage youngsters to pursue activities, in natural settings ranging from river

valleys to high mountain spots. They are designed primarily for young people, but can be used by all ages. The bedrooms are equipped with bunk beds or wooden floor and you need to bring a sleeping bag with you.
