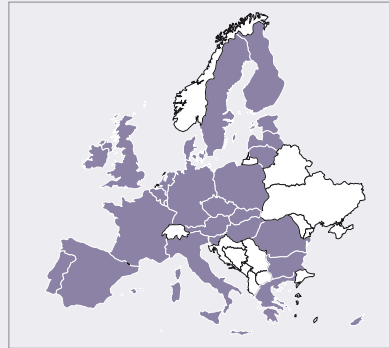

# Who can vote?

## 1 European Union citizens

You must be registered in the Electoral Roll before **30<sup>th</sup> December 2014**

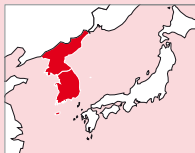


## 2 Non European Union citizens with Agreements

- Bolivia
- Chile
- Colombia
- Ecuador
- Paraguay
- Perú
- Trinidad and Tobago



- Korea



- New Zealand



- Cape Verde



- Norway
- Iceland



To register in the Electoral Roll you must have been residing in Spain for a legal and uninterrupted period of 5 years.

You must be registered in the Electoral Roll before the **15<sup>th</sup> January 2015**.

# Requirements for voting

## 1

You must be 18 years old by the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 2015.

## 2

You must be registered as a resident in the city in which you would like to vote.

## 3

You must be registered in the Electoral Roll before the **30<sup>th</sup> December 2014** for EU citizens, and before **15<sup>th</sup> January** for non EU citizens of countries with Agreements.
