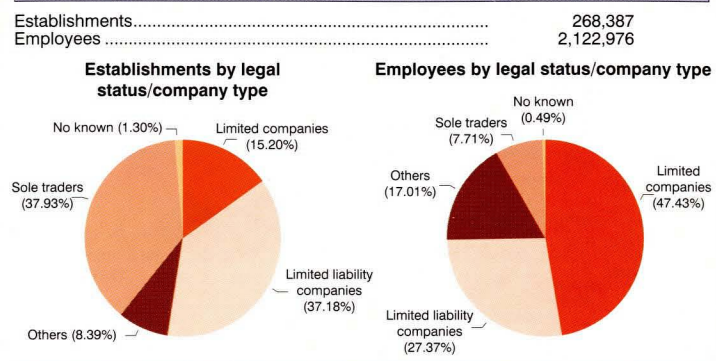


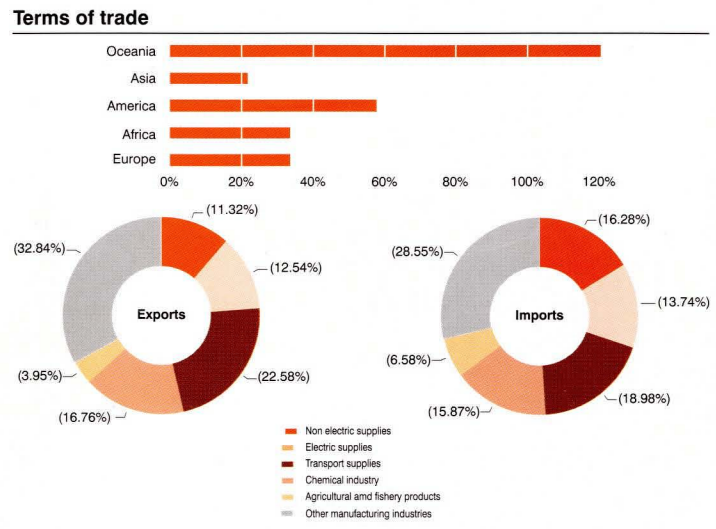

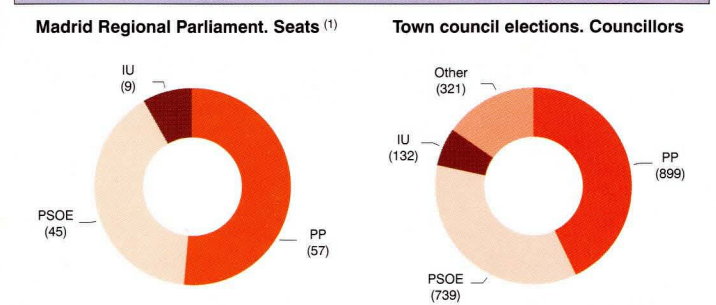

Foreign trade. 2002



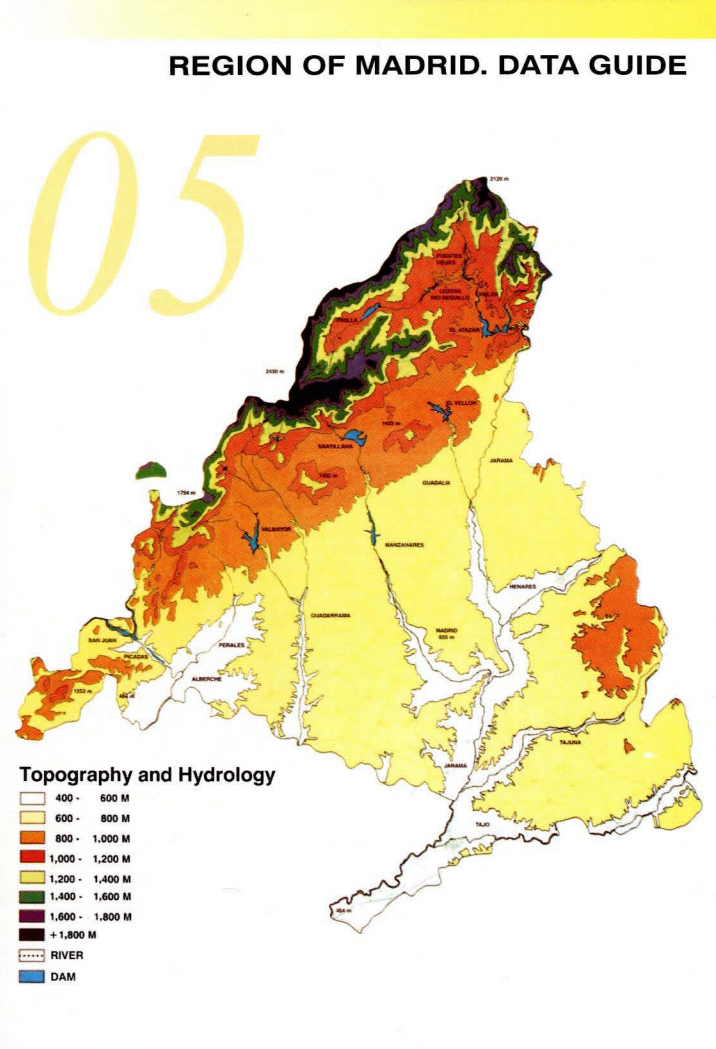

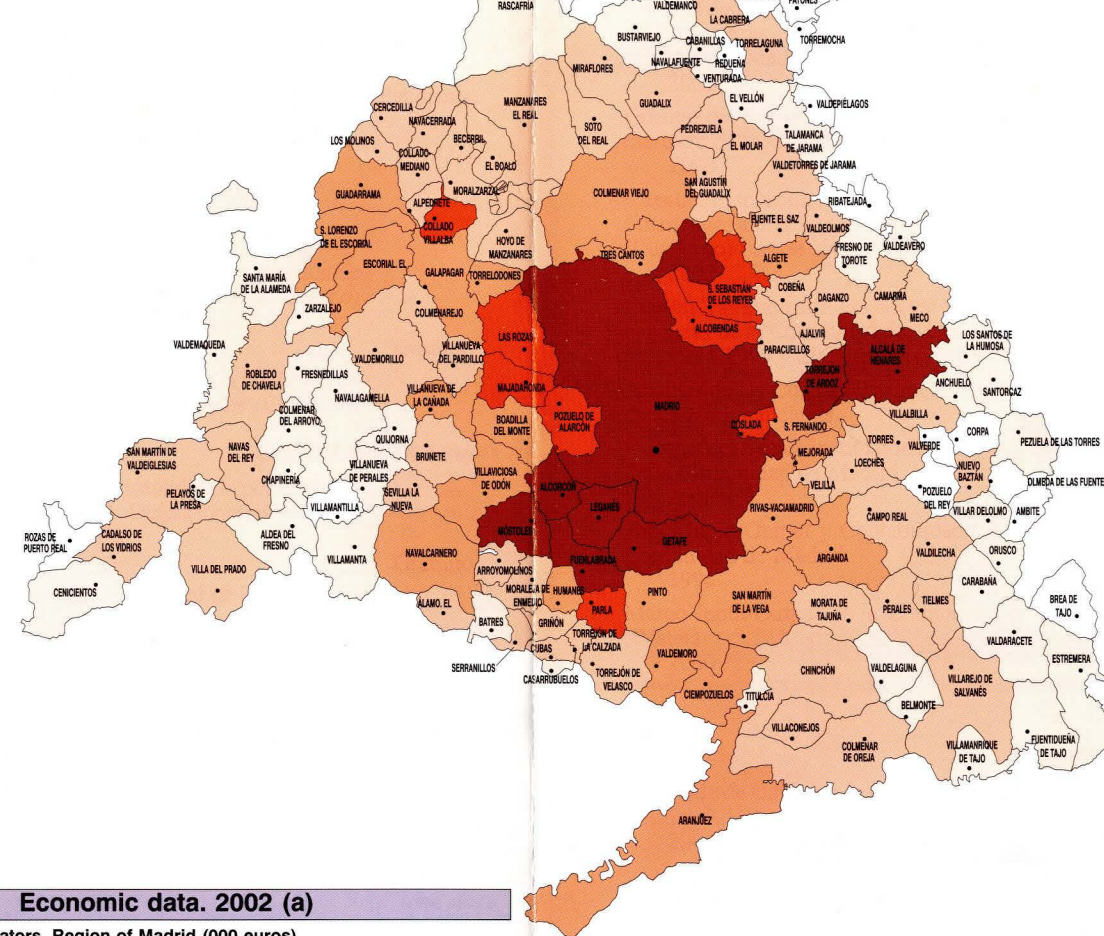

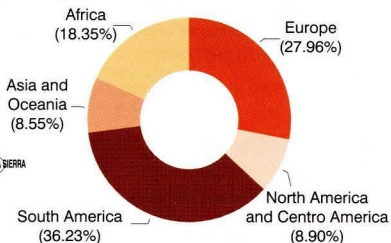

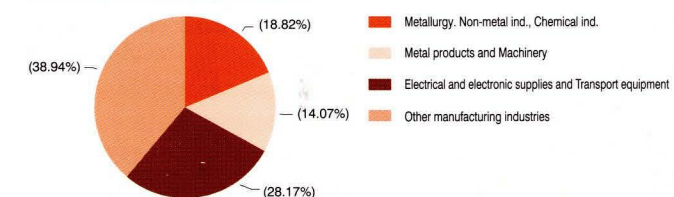
